Job Description:

As a housekeeper, participants are responsible for cleaning (washing, dusting and vacuuming, tidying) guest rooms and property common areas thoroughly as trained and assigned by the employer. Job duties include picking up after a guest, preparing fresh linens (doing laundry), making beds, dusting furniture and fixtures, washing floors, vacuuming carpeted areas, emptying trash cans, cleaning windows (usually less frequently), cleaning the bathroom and toilet and keeping the guest rooms stocked with accessories and the bathrooms stocked with supplies. Housekeepers will be using cleaning chemicals. Prior experience a major plus.

Typical Schedule:

Participants should expect to be scheduled 6 -7 days per week for the mid-morning to afternoon when the last rooms have been cleaned. (AVERAGE 32 hours) per week.

Boston Logan Airport

Arrival:

OPTION 1: (THIS IS THE RECOMMENDED ROUTE) From the airport terminal, take FREE SHUTTLE to the BLUE LINE "Airport" Subway Station. Take the BLUE LINE in the direction of "Bowdoin" to GOVERNMENT CENTER. Get off and transfer to the GREEN LINE toward "Lechmere." Ride for TWO STOPS and get off at NORTH STATION. This ride will cost you \$2.00. Or you may take a taxi from Boston Logan Airport to North Station.*This will cost you at least \$25 US.AT NORTH STATION buy a ticket on AMTRAK's Downeaster train to Old Orchard Beach, ME. Check www.amtrak.com for a schedule and fares. There are 5 trains every day, you can see the schedule on the website (make sure you enter Boston North Station and Old Orchard Beach, ME) and the cost is \$24.

OPTION 2: You have bus Concord Coach Lines that goes directly from Boston Logan Airport from Terminal E to Portland bus station, you can ask for more information on information desk on the airport when you arrive or check schedule www.concordcoachlines.com. Cost of the ticket is 29\$. It takes around 2 hours from Boston to Portland and you can take a taxi after that to Old Orchard Beach! A taxi will cost you approximately \$30-45.

Option 3 from PWM:

Directions from Portland International Jetport(PWM) to Copley LaReine Motel:

After arriving at Portland Jetport, you could take a taxi (\$50-\$70).

If Possible we will try to have some one meet and pick you up from the Bus station and airport in Portland Maine. (based to time of arrival)
