The main house has 4 individual bedrooms with queen size bed and clothing storage with space for one student. Shared kitchen and bathroom facilities in a common area. \$300 a month plus a \$300 security deposit. Bunk house is open living space with 4 single beds. Shared kitchen and bathroom facilities in a common area. \$150 a month plus \$300 security deposit. Housing is located next door to Denali Brewpub. Security deposits will be returned in full unless rental agreement is broken. Linens will be provided. Shared kitchen has full size refrigerator, plates, utensils, and pots/pans. There is a washer and dryer on site.

## Arrival Instructions:

You should plan to fly into Ted Stevens International Airport (ANC) in Anchorage, Alaska, and take a train or bus to Talkeetna.

Travel by train can be coordinated with The Alaska Railroad (https://www.alaskarailroad.com/). A one-way ticket from Anchorage to Talkeetna costs \$108, estimated.

The Park Connection offers travel by bus (https://www.alaskacoach.com). A one-way ticket from Anchorage to Talkeetna costs \$70, estimated.

You must notify Alice Byrd (aliceg@denalibrewing.com) of your arrival date at least two WEEKS prior to arrival.

Please arrive Monday - Thursday in Anchorage and plan to spend a night or two. This will give you time to apply for your SSN if needed.

Note: You will not be allowed to take your luggage into the Social Security Office with you.
