ACCOMMODATION

Housing is not provided. Participants are required to find housing on their own, and the employer will assist. Housing costs will range from \$500 to \$900 per month, per person, on a sharing basis, depending on the location and the type of housing available.

<u>P/S:</u> The employer assists heavily with the accommodation and goes all the way to ensure housing is secured before participants' arrival. Housing is never a concern or issue for past participants!



UNIFORMS & GROOMING STANDARDS

Uniform

All employees may wear blue denim jeans, khakis, colored jeans, or slacks. No leggings or athletic wear. All pants must be clean with no holes, fraying, tears, or rips. Uniform shirts will be issued by Wardrobe for uniformed positions. You may request a uniform jacket and hat. Uniform pants may also be provided upon request.

Grooming Requirements

Hair: to be clean, neatly groomed, away from the face, and of "natural" color. Hair is to be no longer than collar length or pulled back in a ponytail.

Facial Hair: Must be trimmed (1") and maintained.

Tattoos: Must be covered if larger than 2".

Earrings and facial piercing: 3 earrings per ear, and plugs have to be smaller than ¼" and covered.
