Company Description:

Logan's 921 is a full-service 100-seat restaurant in the Adirondack Mountains in New York State. The owner was formerly Anthony Bourdain's sous chef in Manhattan.

The Adirondack Mountains have lakes, hiking, camping, boating, kayaking, etcetera. Our restaurant and housing are located in the heart of the town and are a five-minute walk to the lake. The town has many shops, a grocery store, numerous restaurants, post office, bank - everything you need is within walking distance. The town is called Speculator and is located about one-hour from Lake George. We are 90-minutes from Albany (the capital of New York State), then just a 2.5-hour train ride to New York City.

We have two floor staff housing available with a private bathroom for staff only, which is a two-minute walk to the restaurant.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Job Description:

Front of the house staff will bartend, wait tables and hostess.

Bartenders will serve food and drinks to customers. If students don't know how to make a drink it is fine to look up the recipe on a phone. Waitstaff will take orders from customers for food and drinks and deliver the food to the table, then clear the table and bring additional items as people order them.

Host/hostesses will meet customers at the door, seat them at a table, hand them menus and explain the daily specials.

Front of the house staff is responsible for making sure the front of the restaurant is clean (sweep floors, wipe tables and menus, set tables, fill salts, peppers, sugars, stock ketchups, to-go containers, etc.)

Wait staff and bartenders receive tips from customers. Hosts and hostesses receive 10% of the wait person's tips for helping seat customers, clean and reset tables for the next customers.

Typical Schedule:

A lunch shift is from 11am - 4pm. A dinner shift is from 4pm - 10pm. A bartending shift is from 4pm - 2am at the very latest. Often we close earlier than 2am; by law 2am is the latest.

Seasonal changes to job duties or available hours: Yes

July through the first days of September we are open 7 days per week, 11:30am to 9:30pm. Before July and after beginning of September we are open 5 days per week, 11:30am to 8pm or 9pm.
