Students must arrive on a specific, pre-determined arrival day for a two-day training class. From Philadelphia, take airport train to Market East, walk to Greyhound bus station at 10th Street/Filbert St. Take bus 551 towards Atlantic City, change to bus 319 towards Wildwood.
