Steamboat Ski and Resort is a Winter and Summer Resort located in the NW corner of Colorado. It takes approximately three-hours to drive here from Denver. Steamboat is small town; a place where you'll find outdoor adventure. Our summer weather consists of sunny, warm days followed by cool, refreshing evenings. You'll have opportunities to indulge in the arts, attend a western rodeo, soak in mineral-rich hot spring pools, dance at outdoor music concerts, explore mountain hiking and biking trails and ultimately unwind in the Colorado Rocky <u>Mountains</u>.

The local Steamboat Springs Transit operates <u>public bus service</u> that runs on a regular and frequent schedule. The bus stops at our employee housing area to transport you to the workplace, ski lifts, grocery stores or any part of town - and it's free!

The Steamboat Ski & Resort Corporation maintains fully furnished employee housing. Housing consists of two bedroom/two bath condominium units located approximately one mile (1.6 km) from the base area. These units are fully furnished, down to the cookware; you only need to bring linens, towels and any entertainment components (a TV and cable box is provided for each unit). Rent is based on two or three people per room (total of four to six occupants in one unit).

The Ponds at Steamboat in Steamboat Springs, Colorado is the employee housing complex owned and operated by Steamboat Ski & Resort Corporation (SSRC). Located on the Steamboat Springs city bus route, about 1.5 miles from the resort. The Ponds property consists of two ponds, extensive lawn areas, a basketball court and easy access to both the Yampa River and the Core Trail. Amenities include full kitchens with dinnerware, cookware, coffee maker, toaster, microwave and dishwasher, cable television, wireless internet, local phone service, and barbeque grill access in the summer. Our accommodations are some of the most convenient and affordable in Steamboat! The Ponds Housing Office • The Ponds Housing Office is part of SSRC's Human Resources Department. • The Housing Office handles all housing matters; applications, leasing, maintenance and tenant/roommate issues. • The Housing Office hours are Monday – Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. • There are two Resident Managers who live on property and are available on-call 24 hours a day for emergencies. The Ponds Location • The Ponds are located on Walton Pond Circle. From HWY 40 turn west on Weiss Drive. Go past the bus stop towards the left and you will be on Walton Pond Circle. • The Housing Office is located at 795 Walton Pond Circle, Unit A1. The Ponds Fees • There is a \$50 per bed, non-refundable administrative fee due upon application approval. Entire apartment rentals have a nonrefundable administrative fee of \$100 for One-Bedroom apartments and \$200 for Two-Bedroom apartments. • For dog owners only there is a \$50 non-refundable dog fee per dog due upon application approval. • These fees are non-refundable and are separate from and not a part of the deposit. • A surcharge for heating costs may be added to the monthly rate to cover any unanticipated increases in fuel costs. Included in the Monthly Rent • The apartments are fully furnished. Electricity, heat, water, trash, local phone, wifi, and basic cable are all included in your rent. A TV for the living room and kitchenware are also provided. You will need to provide your own bedding and towels. Lease Terms • The Ponds leases are month to month. - You will be required to attend a couple orientations after arrival. Please keep an eye on your email about scheduling these.
