Please note:

- Flights to Colorado and transportation to the hotel are not included. Participants must arrange their (own) airfare and transportation to and from the hotel.
- All participants are responsible for transportation to and from The Broadmoor for their work schedule, i.e., walking, bicycle, taxi, or city bus with a monthly bus pass available.

Work Hours and Wages

Your job will be confirmed during an interview based on your skills, experiences, and performance, as well as according to company needs. The hourly wage rate varies according to the position but is **guaranteed at \$14.42 per hour**, with some positions entitled to service charges, tipping, or gratuities. Training will be provided and paid for.

Wages will be paid every two weeks. All positions offer a minimum of 32 hours per week throughout the summer. Those hired will be expected to work Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays unless otherwise mentioned. Overtime is also paid if one works over 40 hours in a week, if applicable.

Note:

- The start date is **strictly on May 27 or June 6** and lasts through the end of the summer program.
- Participants must be able to work for a minimum of a 3-month commitment.
- Participants who are unable to meet the requirements need not apply.
- Please plan your travel after your work-end date.

Job Opportunities

We are recruiting students with positive attitudes, cheerful personalities, and professionalism to join our team. The majority of the positions are customer-facing and involve working with staff and guests.

Participant positions will be offered and determined based on their skills, experience, English, etc. One should be open and ready to accept any position given. If you are not flexible, please do not apply.

Busser/Food Runner

Wage: \$5.42 + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Assist the Chef, culinary team, and serving team by expediting food from the kitchen to the guests quickly and efficiently by facilitating communication and assessing quality

Café Attendant (Café Julie's, Natural Epicurean)

Wage: \$14 + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Greet guests in a friendly, timely manner. Obtain items requested by customers or receive items selected by customers. Prepare beverages requested by customers quickly and confidently, and maintain a thorough knowledge of coffee drinks.

Pool Attendant

Wage: \$14 + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Greet guests, make reservations, give directions, sales rentals, and towels and provide hospitality to guests. Ensure guests are provided with all the possible services available at the pool and provide a safe, clean, and friendly facility for our guests to enjoy.

Host/ess

Wage: \$14.00 + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Responsible for greeting and seating guests, making reservations, and providing hospitality to guests.

Outlet Server and Pool Server

Wage: \$6.42 + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Responsible for function set-up and breakdown, places orders, and serves food/beverages.

Banquet Server

Wage: \$2.17/hour + service charge (guaranteed \$14.42 per hour)

Description: Responsible for function set-up and breakdown, places orders, and serves food/beverages.

Seven Falls Park Attendant

Wage: \$15/hour

Description: Performs duties needed to assist park guests with any and all needs, maintain the park grounds and facilities, seasonal activities, general park information, and trail maintenance.

Accommodation

Housing will be provided at Bijou West (314 W Bijou Street) for the duration of the program at \$110 per week and will be paid through payroll deduction. A one-time, non-refundable \$50 cleaning deposit will also be deducted.

Participants will share a room with 3 other participants of the same gender, each with their (own) bed. All rooms come equipped with a small refrigerator and a microwave. A community kitchen, laundry facility (\$3.00 per load), cable, and Wi-Fi are available on the property.

The accommodation is a secure building with evening security and only houses international employees working at The Broadmoor. It is about 4.5 miles from the resort. There is a bus that runs near Bijou West and drops off near The Broadmoor (no transfer is required).

All participants should be prepared to take the bus and/or arrange their (own) transportation to and from the hotel. The employer will share the transportation (bus) information with the hired participants during orientation.

Arrival Instructions

Participants may arrive 2 to 3 days before the start date to settle into housing and Colorado Springs.

We strongly recommend that you plan to fly directly into Colorado Springs Airport (COS) when you are making your travel arrangements.

If you choose to fly into Denver International Airport, you will need to secure your (own) transportation to the housing provided by The Broadmoor, which is about 75 miles away. Transportation from Denver to Colorado Springs can be very costly (especially if you take a taxi)! Public shuttles are available and more affordable from Denver to Colorado Springs.

Concerning Flight Information

Participants who have a US visa approved are advised to have their travel arrangements booked as soon as possible and update the Broadmoor team accordingly.

All participants must submit flight information directly to The Broadmoor with at least 14 days' notice to ensure that housing is ready for arrival and check-in (link to be provided).

Participants will receive an email from The Broadmoor's international team regarding arrival instructions and onboarding when the employer receives their submitted flight details.
