PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Job Description:

You will read tickets and fulfill orders accordingly with accuracy and speed. Most orders will involve selecting a bagel and adding cream cheese or selecting a pastry. The kitchen will make the hot food. You will be required to match the kitchen ticket to the front counter ticket and deliver the food to the customer. You will also be responsible for stocking the front of the house, cleaning the area, cleaning the store in general, taking out the trash, communicating with the kitchen, being pleasant to other staff and customers, and if possible, using the clover cash register (although this is not a requirement of the job if you cannot do this). You will be standing all day with one break of ten minutes. You will fill the bagels, ice cups, fill cream cheese, sides and pickles. Friendly and team players are the best candidates. This is a very busy store. If you are not good under pressure this will not be a good fit - you need to hustle here- but the tips are worth it. Cleaning, sweeping, wiping, moving furniture to clean, stocking soda cases, bringing in soda and cases of products from the outdoor shed, cleaning the outdoor seating area, hosing outdoor areas, washing the floor, cleaning the bathroom and all general upkeep. Dress neatly with hat on head, a closed toe shoe such as a sneaker, long hair tied up and dressed casually with no vulgar or controversial sayings or words on clothes. No ultra short shorts. You will be supplied with three shirts to wear and are responsible to wash them. This position will also need

at least one person to help with the kitchen prep. You may be asked to cut, slice, help prepare and prep food in the kitchen.

Other qualities that we are looking for are friendly outgoing personalities who can get along with others, make customers happy by responding to their needs, team players who work well under pressure. The summer season is three times as busy as a winter day. We need employees who can work in a neat organized quick and accurate manner who won't get frazzled when the line is wrapping around the store. You will be expected to stand for the entire shift and always be busy. No cell phones are allowed on the floor and one ten minute break is provided. Employees are welcome to take home leftover bagels at the end of the day but are expected to pay half for the food they eat here. Free coffee, tea, iced tea or pure filtered water is available all day but employees are expected to bring their own cup with their name on it.

Typical Schedule:

This job starts as early as 5 am but can start as late as 9 am. Ends no later than 4 pm and you will work at least 40 hours a week. Overtime is available if you want it but is not a requirement.

No jewelry on hands or wrists as per health code, no watches.

No cell phone or earbuds while working. If you eat it, you are expected to pay for it. You can have all the coffee, iced tea and water that you want but you need to bring your own cup. If you smoke you will only get one ten minute break a day. At no other time will you be allowed to go off the floor to eat or smoke. Employees must follow health code rules. Please be friendly to coworkers and customers. If you smoke, you will be asked to smoke outside at the available housing. It is a no smoking house. We will do our best to accommodate your needs however, working on the weekends is mandatory. You should be sober and responsible at all times. Side work such as landscaping, yard work and outdoor maintenance is available if you are interested.
