Job Description:

A Guest Ranch Worker is either a housekeeper, dishwasher, banquet helper, or host.

Housekeepers are in charge of preparing guest cabins for nightly rentals. Working with a team to complete cleaning tasks and helping with laundry.

Dishwashers work in the kitchen and clean the dishes used in the restaurant and for banquets. Dinner is provided nightly for all staff working.

Banquet helpers will set up tables, chairs, and linens for an event, put food out, bus tables, and clean-up after an event. Good English is required. Dinner is provided nightly for staff.

Job placement will depend on English language skills and interests.

Typical Schedule:

Housekeeping is 5 days a week 9am to 5pm. Dish-washing is 5 days a week 3pm to 11pm. Banquets are 5 days a week 1pm to 9pm. Extra work is available to those that want to work more than 5 days a week.
