You will be assigned various duties at the store including assisting customers, stocking merchandise on shelves, and pulling merchandise to the front of the shelves as it becomes shopped down. There is the possibility of working as a cashier or in one of the perishable (bakery, deli or produce) departments but we will not assign these jobs until after everyone has arrived. The cashier position will depend on your knowledge of U.S. currency and English skills.

Red Lodge (www.redlodge.com) is located 96.6 Kilometers southwest of Billings, Montana at the edge of the Beartooth Mountains, along one of America's most scenic highways, (www.beartoothhighway.com), leading to Yellowstone National Park (<http://www.nps.gov/yell/index.htm>). From November to April our ski resort (www.redlodgemountain.com) and beautiful snow covered mountains are the main attraction.

During the winter months, you will have the opportunities for nordic skiing, alpine skiing, backcountry skiing (if you have appropriate experience) or snowshoeing.

HOUSING AND TRANSPORTATION

Employer-owned or employer-arranged housing description:

You will be living in company owned housing, "The Bunkhouse" in Red Lodge a short distance, approximately ½ mile (.8 Kilometers) from the grocery store where you will be working. Employee Housing for seasonal employees is Dormitory-style. There is a shared kitchen on the main floor and each employee provides for their own meals and food. You will have secured storage areas for your food and cooking utensils. Laundry facilities and a common room are also located on the first floor. You must live in the company housing throughout your stay with us. Your housing cost will be \$87.00 per week (\$350.00 per month). There is a required cleaning/damage deposit of \$200.00 along with your first months' rent of \$350.00, a total of \$550.00 due upon your arrival. After the first month your rent will be deducted from your paycheck. Rent includes utilities and high-speed internet. We will have linens and bath towels for your use. Please bring enough money for your basic needs for at least two weeks.
