ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

There are two options for your travel to Lake Tahoe. We suggest flying into Reno Tahoe International Airport as it is the closest airport to us. Alternatively, you can fly into San Francisco International Airport. This is further away, but may offer more flight options and be more affordable.

1) Reno Tahoe International Airport

If you are flying into Reno Tahoe International Airport, you will have to book with North Lake Tahoe Express to arrive at your place or with Lyft and Uber (sometimes it might be cheaper). Another way is to take a bus from Reno to Truckee (\$12) and then use the free bus TART to go to your place. You'll start working with Euro Snack on 06/20/2024 so please arrive a few days early to rest, discover the lake and recover from jet lag. Do not hesitate to use TART and TART Connect to visit the Lake and come to work, both of them are free transportations.

2) San Francisco International Airport

If you are flying into San Francisco International Airport, you will have to take a bus from San Francisco to Truckee. Then from Truckee, you can use TART and TART Connect to go to your place. The bus is free in this area.

Please feel free to arrive a few days early to rest, discover the lake and recover from jet lag.
